

Dunard Values and our Golden Rules

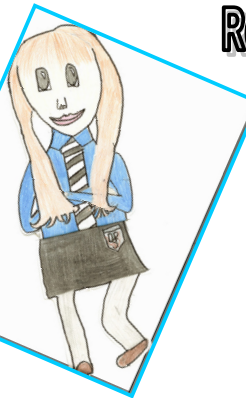

We are kind and helpful



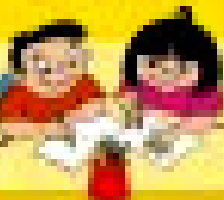

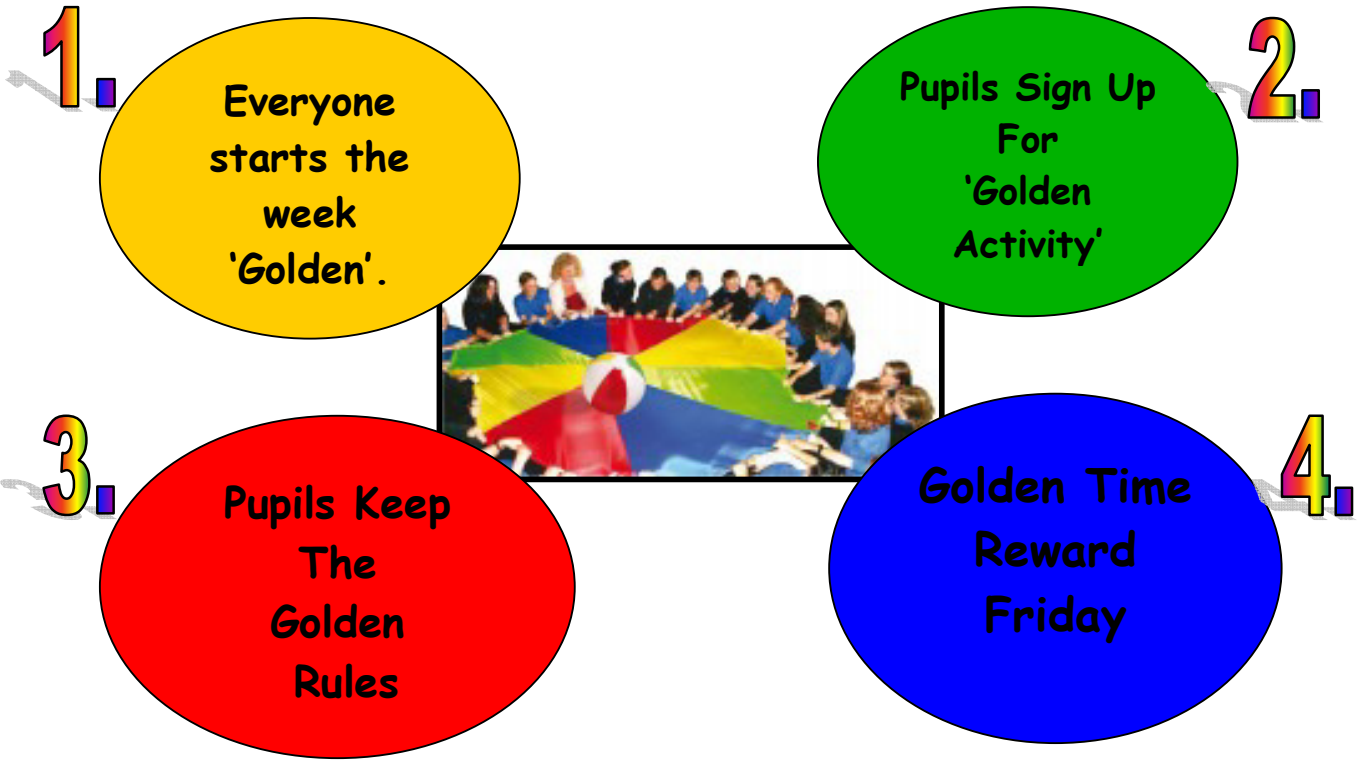




How Does Golden Time Work?




Break Golden Rules Choose to Lose Golden Time
