Learning and teaching is designed around the eight curricular areas of the *Curriculum for Excellence*. This term, our foci include...



Literacy and English

This term, P3/2 will cover:

Reading – Super 6 strategies through picture books and ORT reading books; familiarity with terminology.

Writing – skills for writing such as punctuation and descriptive words and writing adventure stories using the Pie Corbett Talk 4 Writing method. We will also be writing our weekly news.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> – Sharing our news with shoulder partners and the class and preparing and delivering a 1 minute talk about ourselves.

Numeracy and mathematics

In term 1, P3/2 will cover:

<u>Number</u> - revising number sequencing and place value up to 50 and addition and subtraction within 50.

<u>Beyond Number</u> – Information Handling (bar graphs, tally tables) Position and Movement (building up their directional vocabulary) and Time (specifically days of the week / months of the year)

Expressive arts

YMI Music tutor this term and Pirate Songs. In Art, P3/2 will be using mixed media to design and create art pieces related to Pirates.

Social Subjects

This term, P3/2 are studying Pirates – both from a historical view point and also a brief look at Piracy today. We hope to take a trip to the Glen Lee (Tall Ship).
