Learning and teaching is designed around the eight curricular areas of the *Curriculum for Excellence*. This term, our foci include...



Literacy and English

In grammar, pupils will be learning about nouns, verbs and tenses.

Writing will be influenced by our topic, *Weather*. producing functional pieces such as letters and reports. We will also be looking at imaginative writing and poetry in particular acrostic poems.

Pupils will participate in whole class reading lessons, focusing on the Super 6 reading skills. This term we will be looking at predictions, visualization and connections.

Numeracy and mathematics

This term P2 will be learning about place value up to 100 and ordinal numbers.

In information handling, pupils will learn about various ways that information can be displayed. They will learn how to create graphs, displays and Venn diagrams to show this.


Expressive arts

Health and wellbeing
