Learning and teaching is designed around the eight curricular areas of the Curriculum for Excellence. This term, our foci include...



This term, P4 will read The Iron Man and analyse the story using the Super Six reading comprehension strategies.

We will learn stories according to Pie Corbett's Talk 4 Writing scheme and these will used to inspire and up-level our writing this term.

P4 will continue to have weekly spelling and grammar lessons.

As part of our topic, the class will discuss ideas in groups, present their work to each other and provide peer feedback as part of talking and listening.

Numeracy and mathematics

Our Number focus will be fractions and addition and subtraction this term.

We will also learn about using money, angles and compass directions during Beyond Number lessons.

Expressive arts

We will use our class novel, The Iron Man, to inspire our artwork and it will also provide opportunities for designing models.

P4 will continue to have fortnightly input from a music tutor. They will be focusing on identifying aspects of rhythm and beat and will develop their singing and use instruments during the lessons.

Health and wellbeing
