
Primary 1 Newsletter

Learning and teaching is designed around the eight curricular areas of the *Curriculum for Excellence*. This term, our foci include...



Literacy and English

This term, P1 will use Jolly Phonics to learn the next set of letter sounds, actions and songs. They will work on the correct formation of the letters and will be encouraged to blend sounds together to make simple words – e.g. s-a-t.

The class will continue to read Oxford Reading Tree stories to develop their reading skills. They will also start to develop their writing by learning about full stops, capital letters and simple sentences.

Pupils will work on their talking and listening skills by speaking and performing in front of an audience during the Christmas Nativity.

Numeracy and mathematics

P1 will be learning about numbers up to 20 and will take part in activities to develop counting. They will also learn about money and use pennies up to 10p. The class will be introduced to simple addition and will also learn about 3D shapes.

Expressive arts

P1 will create art work linked to our topic, People Who Help Us – World of Work and participate in seasonal craft activities.

This term, P1 will have music input from a YMI tutor and build on their learning about beat, pitching, singing and listening skills.

They will also learn songs for the Christmas Nativity as well as develop their drama and talking and listening skills.

Health and wellbeing

P1 will continue to take part in weekly PATHS sessions (*Promoting Alternative Thinking Strategies*).

This term, the PE focus will be gymnastics and games.
