Learning and teaching is designed around the eight curricular areas of the *Curriculum for Excellence*. This term, our foci include...



#### **Literacy and English**

Primary 7 will conclude their study of *Tom's Midnight Garden* using their 'Super Six' reading strategies (Visualise, Monitor, Predict, Connect, Question and Summarise) to complete a variety of tasks.

There will also be opportunities to read passages and texts based on topical events, and a strong emphasis will be placed on reading for enjoyment through the First Minister's Reading Challenge.

Writing this term will include fiction, inspired by seasonal events, and report writing based on The Victorians.

#### **Numeracy and mathematics**

Primary 7 will continue to further their understanding of decimal numbers and of the four operations (add, subtract, multiply and divide) within and using decimal numbers. Additionally, we will be looking at vulgar, equivalent and simplified fractions. In beyond number, Primary 7 will learn about converting units of length (metres, centimetres, and millimetres), percentages of an amount, and volume.

#### **Social Subjects**

This term P7 will study the Victorian era to build a picture of Scotland's heritage and discover how past events have shaped Scottish society today. They will also learn how to use primary and secondary sources to research events in the past.

#### Health and wellbeing

This term, the PE focus will be on Games lessons and Short Tennis. We will continue to complete our daily mile (weather dependent).

We will also be focusing on friendship and respect.

## **Religious and moral education**

This term, pupils will be learning about St. Andrew's Day, Hanukkah and Christmas.

## **Technologies**

In term 2, Primary 7 will be learning about computer programming. We will use a computer programme called 'Scratch' to advance ICT skills.

ICT will also be used to enhance learning across the curriculum, with continued use of SumDog to boost maths skills, and our iPads to engage learners in digital learning.

#### **Science**

In Science, Primary 7 will investigate chemical reactions between solid's, liquids and gases.

## **Expressive Arts**

Linked to our Victorians topic, Art lessons will focus on group collage work, 3D-sculptures, and Christmas art. Additionally, there will be an opportunity for the Primary 7's to audition for the school choir lead by Mr. Stevenson.
