Mystery Words	Sing and Spell	<u>Different Ways</u>
Take turns spelling out the words using a finger on your partner's back and guess what the word is.	Make up a song or rap to help you remember your spelling words. You might want to share this with your class.	Write your spelling words in different ways e.g. really big, really small, bubble writing etc.
